Stand Firm in the Faith

-- Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong. 1 Corinthians 16:13 (ESV)

Have you ever walked on a surface that wasn't solid? Think about different types of uncertain terrain to navigate. Walking through a foam pit is nearly impossible. Trying to make your way through a thick forest is difficult. Wearing crocs or sandals when it is wet is a dangerous proposition. All of these are examples of not having solid footing.

Some people live their lives, from a spiritual standpoint, on shaky footing. Couple this reality with the fact that we live in a turbulent world with obstacles, winds of afflictions and troubles, and our own personal weaknesses. It is not easy to stand solidly in this world.

Our passage today is a command given by the apostle Paul to the church in Corinth. He tells them to be watchful, and "stand firm in the faith." That phrase to stand firm in the faith gets to the heart of our devotion today. To stand firm means to be steady and sure. We are to stand firm in the faith. This means we are not wavering, stumbling, or easily moved. Our feet are planted on a foundation that can hold us. Where do we find this foundation?

We find it in the Word of God, in the gospel of Christ, in the help of the Holy Spirit, and in community with the church. It is in the Scriptures that our lives find a sure foundation. We do not build our lives on sand, but on the rock of God's Word. Only then can we stand secure when the winds and waves crash upon us. We find this foundation in the gospel of Christ.

Our hope is secure. We anchor ourselves to the truth that Jesus has reconciled us to the Father and made us heirs of eternal promises. We find this firm foundation through the Holy Spirit's power to sustain us.

This keeps us steady in the faith. We stand firm in the faith by remaining in fellowship with the church. We do not try to stand alone, but lock arms with other brothers and sisters of the faith. There we find help, encouragement, and strength.



Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand. – Isaiah 41:10

God is in control even in the storm. And he is present with you in the raging fire. He tells us in his word – "When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned, the flames will not set you ablaze." – Isajah 43:2

God is not through with you yet. Irrespective of the challenges and crisis in your life right now, know that God still has so much he wants to do in and through your life.

Walk closely with God in this difficult season. As you walk with him, you will experience him in ways you have never known. He is a comforter and deliverer. He will fight your battles and give you peace. Do not give up now.

Father, I pray for this difficult season right now. I ask that you strengthen us with grace and comfort us with your love. May we know and experience you in new ways in this season. Open our eyes to see hope and let your words come alive in us by your spirit right now. Help us to stand firm in faith and never give up.

Mending the Nets: Two Visions, One Passion. £2.00 The Restoration of God's People.

Patrick Chambron, Director of Ellel Ministries in France and Regional Director for Western Europe, shares his personal testimony of how God guided him and his wife, Valerie, to bring the Christian healing ministry into France, through the complementary visions of two men, Pierre Truschel in France and Peter Horrobin in England. Patrick describes how God chose a church in St-Laurent-du-Pont, The Christian Fellowship, to come into partnership with Ellel Ministries, in order to carry the vision of Luke 9:11 - to welcome, teach and heal - for God's people in France.

This book shows how God used everyday circumstances in Patrick's life so that he was well equipped for this special work that the Lord had purposed for him. Patrick also shares the many occasions when the Lord miraculously opened exactly the right doors for him and provided the necessary finances just when they were needed.

Christmas 1975 and Queen's Bohemian Rhapsody is riding high in the charts. In a residential street just outside Cardiff a loud knocking breaks the stillness of the evening. When Rob Parsons, a young lawyer, opens his door, he finds a homeless man standing before him, clutching a bag of belongings and a frozen chicken. Rob and his wife Dianne invite Ronnie Lockwood into their home, cook his chicken and offer him shelter for the night. What happens next is an astonishing story of human kindness, self-learning, incredible pain, unbelievable hope and the sheer power of love to change a life.

A Knock at the Door is the true story of this homeless man who entered the home of a young couple, became a dustman and lived as part of their family for over forty-five years until his death. But this is not just Ronnie's story – it is also that of the young couple and their children.
